EUROPA CANTAT Utrecht 2009

We are happy to report that the festival EUROPA CANTAT XVII in Utrecht was a great success. More than 2.600 singers and conductors from 50 countries worldwide participated in the festival with over 80 concerts and 119 ateliers and seminars. There were 800 one-day visits of people from the Netherlands and from abroad who wanted to get a taste of the festival and more than 30.000 visits to the concerts. More than half the participants were under 27, though the oldest were well over 80. And for the first time Europa Cantat offered a training programme for young event managers in the field of choral music.

City of Utrecht Gives Award to EUROPA CANTAT

The City of Utrecht awarded a 'Golden Dom Tower' to Europa Cantat President, Jeroen Schrijner, at the closing ceremony of EUROPA CANTAT XVII festival in Utrecht on 25 July. The Dom Tower award is given to those who have made a significant contribution to change in the City. The City wished to express its gratitude for 'bringing this spectacular event to Utrecht'. EUROPA CANTAT XVII has left lasting traces in the City: choral events with children, integration choirs in socially deprived areas, and even a large choir made up entirely of City staff and politicians. In addition, the festival had kept its promise and turned Utrecht into a friendly, singing city for more than a week. Schrijner thanked the City for an award he said he regarded as a fine token of appreciation for all those who had worked to make the festival a success and for the thousands of singers, conductors and others who had taken part of the event.

Memorandum from Conference on Singing and Music Education

The Conference on Singing and Music Education which took place in Vilnius, Lithuania at the beginning of July was the first activity in the frame of the EU-funded project „Uniting Youth in Song“ (see below). At the end of the conference the experts formulated a „memorandum“ with a set of recommendations to governments (ministries of education, health, social affairs and culture) and to national and international music organisations. Uniting Youth in Song started

The project “Uniting Youth in Song”, a project coordinated by Länsmusiken in Örebro (Sweden) in cooperation with FENIARCO (Italy), SCIC (Catalonia, Spain), the KÓTA (Hungary), the festival EUROPA CANTAT Utrecht (the Netherlands) and Europa Cantat in Bonn (Germany) has been selected under the European Union programme “Culture 2007 – 2013”. The Conference on Singing and Music Education at the beginning of July (see above) was the official „kick-off“ event for the project. It was followed by a series of activities for children's and youth choirs in the frame of the festival EUROPA CANTAT XVII in Utrecht in July 2009 where the steering committee with representatives of all project partners also met. The next activities in 2009 are the European Academy for Young Conductors in Fano, Italy (specialized in Vocal Pop, applications still possible, see www.feniarco.it), a seminar for children's choir conductors in Örebro, Sweden (see www.swicco.se) and the Hearts-in-Harmony weekend in Budapest, Hungary, in October 2009 (see www.europacantat.org/ecceec). Further projects will follow in 2010 and 2011.

The organisers of past and future „Hearts-in-Harmony“ events (in France, Norway, Hungary, Catalonia - Spain and Sweden) met in the frame of the festival EUROPA CANTAT Utrecht in Europe, together with Thierry Thiébaud, one of the founders of the original initiative „chœurs-en-chœurs“ on behalf of A Cœur Joie. They exchanged information about their respective events and decided to inform each other about future developments and invite each other to the different events. The next event will be the Hearts-in-Harmony weekend for visually impaired and blind young singers in Budapest, Hungary, October 2nd to 4th 2009, an activity in the frame of Uniting Youth in Song.

The conference wants to show the rich diversity of vocal and choral music in the Mediterranean context. It will offer lectures, workshops, presentations and concerts on „Old Traditions - New Concepts“, „Vocal Traditions of the Mediterranean“ and „Tradition, Conservation and Dissemination“. International Competition for Young Conductors

The 5th International Competition for Young Conductors in Ljubljana, Slovenia, was organised by Republic of Slovenia Public Fund for Cultural Activities (JSKD) and its local office in Ljubljana, in cooperation with AGECE, Europa Cantat, the Europa Cantat Central-Eastern European Centre and the Academy of Music Ljubljana. The overall winner of the competition, Dani Juris from Finland, born in 1985, won the first prize (2.000 €), the AGECE special prize as the youngest finalist, as well as the Europa Cantat special prize, the (assistant) conductorship at the festival EUROPA CANTAT XVIII in 2012. The second prize (1.000 €), went to Andreas Felber, Switzerland, the third prize (500 €), to Jerica Gregor Bukovec, Slovenia, and Stefan Vanselow from Germany won a number of special prizes. Maud Hamon from France was awarded an additional special prize from Europa Cantat in the way of a recommendation (the Arbeitskreis Musik in der Jugend, AMJ, in Germany was the first organisation to take up this recommendation and invite her to conduct a workshop at the Youth Chamber Choir Week in Usedom in 2010). The Noël Minet Scholarship went to Aleksandra Samokhvalova from Moscow, Russia. You will find the full results on www.EuropaCantat.org -> news.

After the move of the IFCM General Secretariat to Namur and the resignation of Secretary General Jean-Claude Wilkens in 2008, in January 2009, the process for the recruitment of a new Secretary General was launched; a decision will be made in the coming months. Meanwhile, the Secretary General's position having been vacant since 31 March, the First Vice-President has been requested to take over this role in cooperation with the secretariat in Belgium.

The new statutes adopted in Copenhagen call for the holding of intra-symposia general assemblies, the first of which will take place this year. Thanks to our colleague, Fred Sjöberg, the City and the Governor of Örebro (Sweden), this will happen on October 23 and 24 2009, within the framework of the World Youth Choir's 20th anniversary celebration.

Puerto Madryn is actively preparing this symposium, and the deadline for choirs to register is 1 October 2009. CANTANDO EL MUNDO (Singing the World), the theme of the choral world gathering in Argentina in 2011, will be our slogan for the next two years.

The 2008 Annual Conference of the European Music Council (EMC) was at the same time the final event of the three year EU cooperation project "ExTra! Exchange Traditions", presenting different topics concerning the musical dimension of immigration and multiculturalism. It took place in the Theocharakis Foundation in Athens, Greece and was co-organised with the Greek ExTra! partner En Chordais. More on www.extra-project.eu

The International Music Council (IMC) invites all interested musicians and music organisations to attend its 3rd IMC World Forum on Music and 33rd General Assembly to be held in Tunis, October 17-22, 2009 under the title "Access to Musical Diversity". It will be organised in collaboration with the Ministry of Culture and Heritage Preservation of the Tunisian Republic. The 2009 World Forum on Music will focus on five areas which IMC considers being of crucial importance to the world of music:

- Cultural diversity: where do we stand?
- Music as a vector for dialogue
- Creativity and innovation in music distribution
- New approaches to music education
- Changing audiences: challenges for art music around the world

European Elections - European citizens have voted (at least 43% of them) and the newly elected MEPs are currently negotiating the repartition of power in the new Parliament. With a clear right-wing majority but also the possibility of seeing the Education and Culture Committee chaired by a representative of the Green group, perspectives for the cultural sector are contrasted.

Swedish Presidency- Presidencies of the European Council follow each other with different styles and ambitions. After the overactive French and rather chaotic Czech, Sweden is taking over the presidency of the European Council for six months from 1st July. In addition to the global (economic and social crisis, sustainable development) and European (Lisbon Treaty, new Commission) dossiers, culture will certainly not feature very highly on the Swedish agenda, even if some limited actions have already been announced. Save the date! Culture Action Europe and Intercult are planning a conference on „The architecture of cultural politics“ on 3-4 December 2009 in Stockholm. More info soon.

New Culture Committee for the European Parliament session 2009-2014. Veteran MEP Doris Pack (EPP - Germany) has been nominated as the committee chair. Helga Trupel (Greens - Germany) is returned as vice-chair and continues as a member of the Budgets committee. Otherwise the committee currently comprises 32 full members of which only 5 were present on the committee in the last mandate. In addition there are 30 substitute members.
